

Floating Gardens of the Aztecs

The **Aztecs** used stunning floating gardens otherwise known as "Chinampas" a system of farming (sometimes called floating gardens) is a form of ancient raised field agriculture to grow their crops without harming the environment, used by American communities at least as early as the year 1100 Common Era,(CE), formally known as AD, and successfully used by small farmers today as well. Chinampas are long narrow garden beds separated by canals. The resulting system of canals and gardens created a habitat for fish and birds, which helped maintain the health of the ecosystem and also provided additional sources of food. The garden land is built up from the wetland by stacking alternating layers of lake mud and thick mats of decaying vegetation. The process is typically characterized by exceptionally high yields per unit of land. The word chinampa is a Nahuatl (native Aztec) word, chinamitl, meaning an area enclosed by hedges or canes.
